Deadline: October 15, 2017

Nominations received after October 15 will not be considered.

All parts of the Outstanding Leadership in Science Education Award application should be compiled by the nominator and sent to Michael Brinkman, TSELA President Elect (president-elect@tsela.net) by October 15.

Note: Partial applications will not be considered for the award.

Award Selection:

An Awards Committee judges each application based on a rubric. The Awards Committee represents all regions of the state. The current TSELA president will notify all nominees and the awardee.

Recognition:

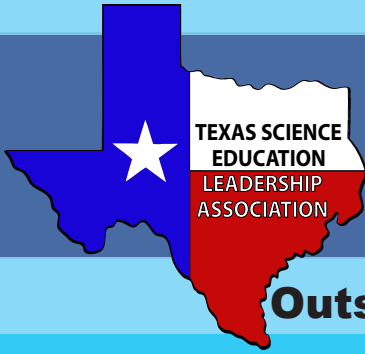
The Outstanding Science Leader will be recognized in the following manner:

- a. Acknowledged and introduced at the winter (CAST) TSELA meeting.
- b. Presented with a plaque, a check for \$750 and a School Specialty "gift."
- c. An article detailing the awardee's contributions in the STATellite newsletter.
- d. Application will be submitted to NSELA in December for the "Outstanding Leadership in Science Education Award" to be awarded at the next NSTA Convention.

Directions:

Both the nominee and the person placing the nomination must be current TSELA members. Please provide the information for numbers 1 – 8 on separate sheets – each question is limited to two pages (10 pt font).

- Candidate's education record.
Include college, attendance dates, degree, and field of study. Also include institutes and special programs.
- List professional organizations of which the candidate is a member.
Any special position held or any special contribution to any organization should be mentioned with dates for office held or contribution made.
- List any special awards or professional recognition the candidate has received within the past 10 years.
- List publications the candidate has written or presentations the candidate has given. For each give title and a brief description.
- Briefly describe the type of supervisory or science leadership capacity in which the nominee is presently engaged. Give the title and responsibilities for the position.
- Briefly describe any prior supervisory or science leadership experience.
- Describe in 500 words or less, the exemplary nature of the nominee's contribution to science education. Include specific contributions the nominee has made to improve a science program and student learning.
- Please include letters of support; no less than 3, or more than 5.
From the following: (a) superintendent or immediate supervisor, (b) a subordinate, (c) other as appropriate.
